

JAMESTOWN CITY COUNCIL  
SPECIAL MEETING, DECEMBER 20, 2006  
OFFICIAL MINUTES

The special meeting of the City Council was called to order by Mayor Liechty at 4:00 P.M.

Roll Call showed the following members present: Mayor Liechty, Council Members Heinrich, Grabinger and Parisien, City Attorney Dalsted, City Administrator Fuchs, and Attorney Curtis Wike (Law Office of Fleck, Mather & Strutz, Ltd.). Absent: Council Member Schulz.

Mayor Liechty moved a Resolution to have the City Council enter into executive session pursuant to ND Century Code Section 44-04-19.1(2)(4) for the purpose of attorney consultation relative to the Charles Strankowski lawsuit. Seconded by Council Member Grabinger. Roll Call No. 1 showed: 4 ayes, 0 nays, 1 absent. Carried.
