

JAMESTOWN CITY COUNCIL  
SPECIAL MEETING, FEBRUARY 15, 2007  
OFFICIAL MINUTES

The special meeting of the City Council was called to order by Mayor Liechty at 8:00 A.M.

Roll Call showed the following members present: Mayor Liechty, Council Members Schulz, Heinrich, and Grabinger, City Engineer Horgan, Fire Chief Gray and City Administrator Fuchs. Absent: Council Member Parisien.

The City Council met in special session for the purpose of acting on a request by Special Olympics North Dakota to be allowed the use of city divers and diving equipment for participation in the fund raising event entitled Polar Plunge to be held February 17, 2007.

Discussion centered on the concern of establishing a policy that would insure worker's compensation and liability coverage for the city divers and the City of Jamestown.

Council Member Grabinger moved a Resolution to allow the use of city fire department divers and equipment to assist with the Special Olympics Polar Plunge and to establish a fee of \$25.00 per hour per diver to be paid by the Special Olympics organization. Seconded by Council Member Heinrich. Roll Call No. 1 showed: 4 ayes, 0 nays, 1 absent. Carried.

Council Member Grabinger moved to adjourn. Seconded by Council Member Heinrich. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.
