

JAMESTOWN CITY COUNCIL  
SPECIAL MEETING, APRIL 18, 2007  
OFFICIAL MINUTES

The special meeting of the City Council was called to order by Mayor Liechty at 9:13 A.M.

Roll Call showed the following members present: Mayor Liechty, Council Members Schulz, Heinrich, and Grabinger, City Attorney Dalsted, City Engineer Horgan and City Administrator Fuchs. Absent: Council Member Parisien.

The City Council met in special session in the Council Chambers at City Hall for the purpose of entering into mediation to attempt settlement of the Strankowski vs. City of Jamestown lawsuit. Included in the mediation session were Curtis Wike, an attorney retained by the NDIRF to represent the City, Jeff McQueen representing NDIRF and Jack Marcell, mediator.

Mayor Liechty moved to have the City Council enter into executive session pursuant to Section 44-04-19.1(5) and Section 44-04-19.2, NDCC for consultation with the City Attorney relative to the Stankowski vs. City of Jamestown lawsuit. Seconded by Council Member Heinrich. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

The Council entered executive session at 9:15 A.M. with the following present: Mayor Liechty, Council Members Schulz, Heinrich and Grabinger, City Attorney Dalsted, Curtis Wike, NDIRF, Jeff McQueen, NDIRF, City Engineer Horgan and City Administrator Fuchs.

The City Council recessed the executive session at 11:43 A.M.

The City Council returned to executive session at 1:30 P.M.

Council Member Heinrich moved to return to regular session at 4:25 P.M. Seconded by Council Member Schulz. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.
