

**PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE,

Schulz moved to recommend that the Council approve and authorize the submission of a grant application to the U.S. Department of Justice for a 2006 Justice Assistance Grant, in the amount of \$12,793.00, that will be a joint grant with the Police Department and Stutsman County Sheriff's Department. Seconded by Phillips. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Schulz moved to recommend that the Council reject all bids received for the lease of three patrol vehicles for the Police Department, and approve and authorize purchase of the existing three (3) leased patrol vehicles. Seconded by Phillips. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Schulz moved to recommend that the Council allow police officers to purchase a new service revolver through a twelve (12) month payroll deduction. Seconded by Phillips. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.
