SEPTEMBER 20, 2006

Present: Liechty, Schulz, Heinrich, Grabinger and Parisien, Horgan, Donegan, Sad, Sveum and Fuchs.

Heinrich moved to recommend that the City Council award the bid for the new animal control kennel to be constructed at the Baler Facility to Schumacher Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$59,990.00. Seconded by Parisien. Voice vote showed: 4 ayes, (Schulz, Heinrich, Grabinger and Parisien), 1 nay (Liechty). Carried.

Schulz moved to recommend that the City Council approve and authorize the purchase of a 2003 Ford F450 (18 passenger bus) for the Police Department, from R. M. Stoudt, Inc., in the amount of approximately \$20,000.00 (equipped), and paid for from homeland security grant funds. Seconded by Parisien. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Schulz moved to recommend that the City Council approve and authorize advertising for bids for the direct sale of a 1985 Ford, F350 truck, from the Police Department. Seconded by Parisien. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Consensus of the committee was to repair the existing viaduct pump, if possible, following a reasonable exploration cost to determine feasibility.

Heinrich moved to recommend that the City Council approve and authorize the use of concrete for the shared use path as part of US Hwy 281 Reconstruction, 17th Street SW to 29th Street SW, Project No. NHU-2-281(030)066. Seconded by Grabinger. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Grabinger moved to recommend the first reading of a proposed ordinance to enact Chapter 31 of the City Code pertaining to Storm Water Management. Seconded by Parisien. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.
