Present: Parisien, Kourajian, Schulz, Dalsted, Reuther, Sveum, Sad, Mayhew, Schwartzkopf & Fuchs.

Parisien moved to recommend the City Council approve the request from Kitchen Solvers of SCND for a Renaissance Zone project for the property located on the South Half of Lot 2 & All Lot 3, Block 39, Original Addition (209 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue South). Seconded by Nygaard. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Jamestown College students, Jacob Niemeyer and Mariah Aziz, appeared to present a report on the "Project Curbside Pickup" conducted by the college Character in Leadership class service project.

Nygaard moved to recommend the City Council adopt a Resolution of Support for the Chamber of Commerce Recycling Committee Task Force efforts in drafting a proposal for a city wide recycling program and to request the City Administrator work with the committee in their endeavor. Seconded by Kourajian. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Parisien moved to recommend the City Council award the bids for the following:

- Sidewalk, Curb & Gutter District #10-11 to Schumacher Construction, in the amount of \$69,359.50.
- New Motor Grader for the Street Department to RDO Equipment Company, in the amount of \$205,750.00, with a \$127,000 guaranteed buyback.
- New 4WD Skid Steer Loader and Accessories for the Sanitation Department to Butler Machinery Company, in the amount of \$43,866.00.

Seconded by Kourajian. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Nygaard moved to recommend the City Council approve the selection of AE2S, Interstate Engineering, Inc., and Ulteig Engineering for providing "On-Call" Engineering Services to the City of Jamestown for 2010 and 2011. Seconded by Parisien. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Nygaard moved to postpone discussion of the insurance claim relating to sewer backup at 1205 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave NW, owned by Miles Mickelson, to allow the City Administrator and City Engineer to discuss the claim with the NDIRF and the adjustor on the claim. Seconded by Parisien. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Nygaard moved to recommend the City Council accept the petition and authorize the replacement of curb and installation of a curb driveway section for Dwight Herr, 1306 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue NW, as part of the 2010 Sidewalk, Curb & Gutter District #10-11. Seconded by Kourajian. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Parisien moved to recommend the City Council authorize entering into a Supplemental Contract Modification with Interstate Engineering, Inc., related to the downtown parking lots and quiet zone. Seconded by Kourajian. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Kourajian moved to recommend the City Council authorize entering into engineering agreements with Interstate Engineering, Inc., for the following:

- To open Inert Landfill Cells #5 and #6.
- To open Sanitary Landfill Cell #3B.

Seconded by Nygaard. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Kourajian moved to recommend the City Council authorize engaging Safety-Kleen for waste spill clean-up at the Water Treatment Plant. Seconded by Nygaard. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Pat Rinde and Joseph Schmidt appeared to discuss concerns relating to road maintenance and speeds on 35th Street SE from Cavendish Farms to the Sanitary Landfill site as a result of construction activities in the Spiritwood Energy Park.
