Nygaard moved to table to the November Fire & Police Committee discussion relative to deer depredation concerns within the city to allow Council Member Gumke and Police Chief Donegan to contact the ND Game & Fish Department. Seconded by Schulz. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Andersen moved to recommend the City Council authorize the reimbursement of \$220 to Homer Township for snow removal costs as a onetime exception to City policy relative to shared maintenance costs on periphery roads. Seconded by Schulz. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

A public hearing and the second reading of an ordinance to change the zoning of Lot 1, Block 61, Klaus Second Addition, from R-2-A (One to Twelve Family Residential District) to C-2 (General Commercial District), is scheduled for the November 1, 2010, City Council meeting.

Andersen moved to recommend the City Council authorize engaging Prairie Engineering to prepare the plans & specifications based on Alternate A to include the addition of the replacement of existing fire alarm with an addressable system, as prepared by the City Administrator on the Summary of Electrical Opinion of Probable Construction Costs as presented in the Prairie Engineering Assessment Report for the Civic Center electrical efficiency improvements. Seconded by Nygaard. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.
