PUBLIC WORKS, POLICE & FIRE COMMITTEES

July 26, 2012

Present: Andersen, Gumke, Kourajian, Brubakken, Dalsted, Suko, Reuther, Schwartzkopf, Klundt, Sveum and Fuchs. Absent: Buchanan.

Gumke moved to recommend the City Council authorize engaging Joseph P. Larrivee Architects PC, to provide architectural services necessary for re-roofing the Fire Hall. Seconded by Kourajian. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Brubakken moved to recommend the City Council adjust the fee to \$30.50 per hour as the Airport Rescue Fire Fighting hourly wage for volunteers. Seconded by Gumke. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Kourajian moved to recommend the City Council approve and establish out of County Response Fees for Services at \$500.00 per unit per day plus mileage, lodging and food rates per state rates and any usable goods per replacement cost. Seconded by Gumke. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Andersen moved to recommend the City Council award the bid for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Piping Replacement project to PKG Contracting, in the amount of \$729,000. Seconded by Gumke. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

City Engineer Schwartzkopf provided information to the committee regarding possible truck route designations, no truck sign placements in the area of 3rd St & 12th Ave SE and his intent to contact BNSF regarding possible access easements across railroad property.

City Engineer Schwartzkopf provided information to the committee regarding possible modifications to the Snow Emergency Routes.

Consensus of the committee was to have city staff provide for refuse containers in the downtown railroad parking lots with city crews responsible for emptying the downtown refuse containers on a regular basis.

Gumke moved to recommend the City Council approve the request from Rebecca Partlow of 619 2nd Ave NE to include sidewalk and incidental work to the City 2012 Sidewalk, Curb & Gutter District #12-11. Seconded by Andersen. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Consensus of the committee was to have a draft ordinance pertaining to a 'Dead Animals Handling Policy' prepared for review at the August committee meeting.

Andersen moved to recommend the City Council authorize engaging Baker Engineering, LLC, for Phase I of Traffic Engineering Services Study. Seconded by Kourajian. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.
