Gumke moved to recommend the City Council approve the request from Vining Oil & Gas, LLC, for two – 2 Hour Parking stalls on the west side of the street at 301 2nd Avenue NW. Seconded by Kourajian. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Gumke moved to recommend the City Council establish the week of June 2nd – 7th, 2014, as City Clean – Up Week. Seconded by Buchanan. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Gumke moved to recommend the City Council authorize the Engineering Department to acquire an upgrade in Autodesk AutoCAD software and a three (3) year license subscription, in a total amount of \$6,688.86. Seconded by Andersen. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

Gumke moved to recommend the City Council approve Change Order No. 2, to Swanberg Construction, Inc., for Wastewater Lift Station and Forcemain Improvement Project, Phase 1, CWSRF No. 380808-06, for an increase in the contract price of \$5,543.55. Seconded by Buchanan. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

The committee reviewed the 2014 report of the Jamestown Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan as prepared by the Engineering Department.

Gumke moved to add the Street Foreman and Street Equipment Operator III, as members of the Stormwater Sub-Committee. Seconded by Andersen. Unanimous aye vote. Carried.

The committee members discussed additional considerations relative to the paint scheme for the new southwest water tower.
