

ORDINANCE NO. 1396

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND RE-ENACT SECTION 5-27
OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF JAMESTOWN
PERTAINING TO THE NUMBER OF LICENSES ALLOWED
TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY THE ADDITION OF A CLASS H

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JAMESTOWN, NORTH DAKOTA, that Section 5-27 of the Code of the City of Jamestown is hereby amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

SECTION 5-27. Number of licenses allowed.

The licenses which may be issued for the retail sale of alcoholic beverages in the city shall be divided into the following classes for the purpose of determining the number of licenses to be issued and outstanding. All licenses issued hereunder are at the discretion of the city council and shall be nontransferable.

Class A through Class G. (Same as parent volume)

Class H. To a hotel or motel to provide complimentary alcoholic beverages to registered customers and their guests in their rooms or in a common room or area designated for that purpose. The licensee and patrons shall be subject to all other provisions of Chapter 5 of the Code of the City of Jamestown as they apply, provided:

- (1) Minors may be present in the designated areas as provided for in this license provided their parent or guardian is also present;
- (2) Only employees twenty-one (21) years of age may prepare, serve or deliver alcoholic beverages;
- (3) No minors may consume, possess, be served or deliver alcoholic beverages in the licensed premises.
