

ORDINANCE NO. 1402

An ordinance amending Chapter 2 of the Code of the City of Jamestown, North Dakota, by amending Section 2-57 to set forth regulations concerning the mayor's ability to order a mandatory evacuation of the City of Jamestown.

WHEREAS, the North Dakota Legislative Assembly has enacted new regulations concerning a mayor's authority to order a mandatory evacuation of the city he governs.

WHEREAS, to allow implementation of the new provisions the City Code of the City of Jamestown requires updating.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordered by the City Council of the City of Jamestown, North Dakota, that Chapter 2, Section 2-57, be amended and re-enacted as follows:

Sec. 2-57. Powers and duties of mayor—Proclamation of emergency, mandatory evacuation order.

When in the judgment of the mayor a civil emergency as defined herein is deemed to exist the mayor shall forthwith proclaim in writing the existence of such emergency. When in the judgment of the mayor a mandatory evacuation order is appropriate, the mayor may issue a mandatory evacuation order in accordance with Section 37-17.1-10 of the North Dakota Century Code.
