


BUCHHOLTZ 4/TH ADDITION

To The City of JAMESTOWN, NORTH DAKOTA
Part S.E. 1/4, Sec. 24, T140N, R64W.



DECLARATION OF PLAT

A.G. Buchholtz and V.F. Buchholtz, as owners and proprietors of the hereinafter described parcel of land, together with Donald Wenaas, Registered Professional Engineer and Land Surveyor, and as City Engineer of the City of Jamestown, North Dakota, hereby declare and make known that said owners and proprietors recently caused to be laid out and platted and surveyed a plat of BUCHHOLTZ 4/TH ADDITION to the City of Jamestown, North Dakota; and this plat thereof which is attached hereto was made from an actual survey in accordance with the Statutes of the State of North Dakota, and the Ordinances of the City of Jamestown, North Dakota, in such case made and provided; a description of the situation and boundaries of said plat of BUCHHOLTZ 4/TH ADDITION being as follows:

Said tract is part of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twentyfour (24), Township One Hundred and Forty North (T140N), Range Sixty Four West (R64W), and is more particularly described as follows:
Beginning at the center of said Section 24, T140N, Range 64W, hence S 0 deg. 15 min. E along the North-south quarter line for a distance of 1356.9 feet, hence S 89 deg. 45 min. E. for a distance of 512.7 feet, hence N 0 deg. 15 min. W for a distance of 1353.59 feet, more or less, to the East-west quarter line of said section 24, hence N 89 deg. 53 min. W a distance of 512.7 feet to the point of beginning.

Said tract contains 15.95 Acres, more or less, and is shown on the attached plat.

That the foregoing is a true and accurate description of the situation and boundaries of said BUCHHOLTZ 4/TH ADDITION to the City of Jamestown, North Dakota.

All Streets, Avenues, and alleys, and all Lots and Blocks are particularly described and set forth on the plat, with the names, widths, courses, boundaries, and extents thereof; the blocks being named, and the lots being numbered in progressive numbers. The figures representing the distances, lengths, and breadths, denote feet and decimal fractions thereof. All Streets, Avenues, and alleys are dedicated to the City of Jamestown, North Dakota in trust for public use.

At the time of surveying and laying out of said addition, the proprietors caused to be planted good and sufficient monuments conforming to the Ordinances of the City of Jamestown, North Dakota, and the Statutes of the State of North Dakota covering the same, as shown on the attached plat.

And that said Donald Wenaas, as surveyor of said plat, further certifies that the plat of BUCHHOLTZ 4/TH ADDITION was made by him from an actual survey thereof and the same is in all respects correct and true to the best of his knowledge, and that said plat is hereby approved by him as City Engineer of the City of Jamestown, North Dakota.
