1. A. All radios, equipment, hardware, antennae and related materials for this project **must** be 100% compatible and interoperable with other equipment now in place at the dispatch center of the Law Enforcement Center located at 206 6th St. SE, in Jamestown, North Dakota. All radios and equipment **must** also be compatible with existing radio equipment currently used by the Jamestown Police Department and compatibility must be proven in writing.

B. All radios, equipment, hardware, antenna and related materials for this project **must** be **P-25 analog/digital** and must be 100% compatible with North Dakota State Radio equipment and **must** be assembled and programmed in accordance with North Dakota State Radio and North Dakota Department of Emergency Services specifications and frequency plan, and those frequencies now in use at the Jamestown Police Department.
2. All radio equipment, hardware, antenna and related materials for this project must have a single source warranty and be new.
3. The bidder shall include in the BID ENVELOPE all available literature and service contracts and other information that pertains to the equipment and materials bid.
4. The bidder may include an optional bid that includes a **trade-in** value for the equipment now in place at the Jamestown Police Department.
5. If the bidder has sales and service for more than one brand, the bidder may include one or more options in the bid package. The bid must include a specification sheet for each item bid.
6. All equipment shall be 100% compatible as to interoperability, and the bids will be considered in relation to compatibility, value, warranty, durability, reliability, price and service. Low bid will not automatically be considered the best bid.
7. The bid shall include all costs for all equipment, parts, labor, programming, perpetual licensing, and installation for all phases of the project.
8. The bid proposal shall include assembly and programming of all radios, equipment, antenna, microphones and related materials, which shall all be user ready at the completion of the project.

9. Before installation and use, a complete list of serial numbers and model numbers of all radios, microphones, charges and antennae must be submitted to the office of the Police Chief.
10. The deadline for the completion of this project **shall be no later than November 21, 2018, at 5:00 PM.**
11. All invoices for all project radios and equipment and services shall be presented to the Police Chief no later than **December 26, 2018, at 5:00 PM.**
12. The bid package shall include a letter of assurance that all radios and equipment bid and all installation and programming will comply with FEMA and the Department of Homeland Security interoperability requirements.
